**Saint of the Week**

**St. John the Baptist**

John the Baptist was the son of Zachary, a priest of the temple in Jerusalem, and Elizabeth, a Kinswoman of Mary who visited her. He was born after the Angel Gabriel had told Zachary that his wife would bear a child, even though she was an old woman. He lived as a hermit in the desert of Judea until about A.D. 27. When he was thirty, he began to preach on the banks of the Jordan against the evils of the times and called men to penance and baptism “for the Kingdom of Heaven is close at hand”. He attracted large crowds and when Christ came to him, John recognized Him, saying, “It is I who need baptism from You”. When Christ left to preach in Galilee, John continued preaching in the Jordan Valley. John is presented in the New Testament as the last of the Old Testament prophets and the precursor of the Messiah.
