Let us not take all this for granted, however. It is easy to see the indefiniteness of this holy something. Is it so easy to focus the indefiniteness of this holy something into the distinctness of the divine countenance? Is it easy to feel that our prayer of mind and heart is heard, received and answered? Those who feel this way should indeed be thankful and cherish this gift for it is a great grace.

**Face to face.** God has first called us. He has first addressed me as a person. In doing so he has given me a face of my own, a face whose essential nature it is to turn towards him. And thus, in addressing God directly, I am capable of seeking in my turn his face. And now the Our Father challenges us to speak to him as a person, a "who," and to speak to him directly. No matter where you are, your words will reach him who is in heaven. At any hour, your invocation will find him. There is something immeasurably marvelous in the fact that God is accessible from anywhere at anytime from anything, that the call sent out in the right way never goes astray and reaches its goal. 
