The Badge of the Sacred Heart

The faithful who devoutly wear a badge of white wool suspended from the neck after the manner of a small scapular, with a likeness of the Sacred Heart of Jesus embroidered thereon or otherwise attached, and with the following, or similar words, printed upon it: *Cease, the Heart of Jesus is with us*, or even without any inscription at all, if they say *Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be*, may gain: a partial indulgence, once a day.
