**Pastor's Corner**



Dear Parishioners,

As we close another fiscal year – the time at which all the accounts and finances are finished off and submitted to the diocese – I was asked how we did “spiritually” this year. It is a difficult question to answer! My hope is that we all drew closer to the Altar, to the Sacrifice and to the love of Our God. Hopefully, we depend more and more on Him. That would be a “spiritually successful” year.

I think, however, the person who asked the question was probably looking for a statistical answer, and I decided it would be a good to look into and to share some of those numbers and stats.

This past year we had:

- 22 baptisms (and they keep on coming!)
- 8 wedding preps are currently underway
- 13 receptions of converts into the Church
- 44 First Holy Communions
- 39 Confirmations

Over 100 sick calls, among them 35 emergency calls for Last Rites

And in a busy month, an individual priest hears close to 375 confessions.

Over 50 new families joined the parish, pushing our number of registered parishioners over 1,000!

I have petitioned the FSSP for an additional priest, as we have clearly reached that point. While it would not happen this summer, we shall see what Divine Providence aligns for us in the (hopefully) not too distant future. Please keep this intention in your prayers!

As always, you and your families are in my prayers, especially at the Altar of Our Lord.
