Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners,

A few announcements:

-The Fraternity of St Peter in North America was elevated from a district to a province last month. The new provincial is Fr. William Lawrence FSSP. What this means for us on the practical level is that we now have a major superior in our backyard, with the authority to make assignments. Please keep our new provincial in your prayers!

-Regarding assignments, I am staying put and Fr. Franco is staying put. Deo gratias! Stability is very helpful, especially when the parish has grown so much.

-For the next few months, we will have a third priest visiting. Please welcome Fr. Simon Harkins FSSP to our Richmond apostolate. Fr. Harkins was pastor of St Michael's in Scranton, PA as well as bursar of the North American District. He has been transferred to another parish whose pastorship he will assume. This parish will not be able to receive him for another few months. Meanwhile, he will be helping out around the province, in parishes that need help (hopefully, mostly in Richmond!)

-Repairs and renovations around the parish: some work needed to be done in the courtyard for draining issues. As you recall, our small chapel was flooded during a superstorm last year because of it. Now that the issue has been fixed, the renovation of this small worship space can be planned. Also, one of our HVAC units for a wing of the building has reached the end of the line. It served well since the early 90's and needs replacement. We are working on estimates!

-New doors for several entrances will be replaced, hopefully by the end of the month.
