Dear Faithful,

On the occasion of Corpus Christi, find below a gem of Catholic Theology contained within the Preface of the Most Holy Sacrament:

It is truly meet and just, right and for our salvation, that we should at all times and in all places give thanks to Thee, holy Lord, Father almighty, eternal God, through Christ our Lord. Who, without need of the empty shades of fleshly victims, committed His Body and Blood as a sacrifice for us: that a pure sacrifice, which alone has pleased Thee, might be offered to Thy name in every place. Therefore in this mystery of Thy inscrutable wisdom and boundless charity, that very thing which He once accomplished on the Cross does not cease to be accomplished, He Himself both sacrificing and sacrificed.
