

Blessing of Epiphany Water Thursday, 5 January 2023 at 6 pm

### What is Epiphany Water?

The Epiphany Water blessing is very powerful. Remember the words of our Lord: *Ask and you shall receive. Seek and you shall find. Knock it shall be opened unto you.* While standard Holy Water blessed in the Old Rite contains exorcisms and prayers asking God to defend us against the snares of the evil one, the usual blessings are only a fraction of what we do in the blessing of Epiphany Water. We have the Litany of the Saints, praying of psalms, Pope Leo XIII's exorcism against the fallen angels, the Magnificat, the usual blessings for Holy Water, all capped off with the *Te Deum* in thanksgiving. The whole ritual for blessing the water takes about 30 minutes or so.

Whenever we use properly blessed sacramentals, we enjoy all the prayers offered by Holy Mother Church for all who use them devoutly. If the blessing asks for only one grace, you get that one grace. If the blessing takes 30 minutes and asks for many things, you get to benefit from all those things. Don't forget to add this powerful sacramental to your spiritual arsenal.

### How do I get Epiphany Water?

The parish will have a limited supply of Epiphany Water to share with those who only wish to take a small amount home. Just bring your own empty bottle to fill.

For those who wish to share with friends and relatives, you are permitted to bring jugs of water to be blessed.

- All jugs must be 1 gallon or larger. Anything smaller will not be blessed.
- Beginning on Sunday, 1 January, all jugs can be placed on the floor in front of the Last Supper window behind the pews.
- All water must be brought into the church before the building locks at 12:30 pm, Thursday, 5 January.
- Clearly mark your jugs with your name and phone number.

### Can I watch the blessing?

Yes. The building will reopen at 5:30 pm. Booklets will be available with the English translations so everyone can follow along.

# Blessing of Gold, Frankincense, & Myrrh

## Friday, 6 January 2023 Immediately following the 6 pm Low Mass

The Three Wise Men brought gifts to Our Lord: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. Since Christ our Lord is priest, prophet, and king, they made sure their gifts were worthy. In honor of these gifts given to Our Lord, Holy Mother Church blesses these three items on the feast of the Epiphany. These three gifts represent the threefold office of priest, prophet, and king. Gold represents His royalty, frankincense his priesthood, and myrrh as prophet.

#### How Are These Sacramentals Used?

We can benefit from the graces poured out on this Epiphany day by using these three sacramentals with reverence and devotion. Your golden wedding rings can be blessed on this day. Frankincense and myrrh can be used with a home incense kit while you say your daily prayers as a family. Not only do these two fill the room with a beautiful fragrance while you pray your family rosary, when used with devotion you can receive many graces.

#### Where Do I Bring My Items?

Bring your items to be blessed to the 6pm Mass on 6 January. Please keep them with you as the blessing will take place immediately following Mass. We will only bless things in the Church after Mass so do not place them on the blessing table.


