Dear Parishioners,

Thanks to your generosity, we have been able to maintain a healthy St. Bernadette Fund here at St. Joseph's. The main purpose of this fund is to assist our own parishioners in dire times. I cannot give detailed reports of the many activities of the St. Bernadette Fund because they are confidential. I am writing about it in a general way today so those who are generous may keep on being generous, and those who are in genuine need don't hesitate to reach out.

As a good steward, I must use prudence as the fund, although healthy, is not unlimited. Each case is carefully vetted to determine whether we can assist with partial or full payment of certain bills, and to verify that the requests stem from necessity and not convenience. Also, no money is paid directly to the individual in need; the checks are made out directly to the companies to whom the money is owed.

Here is a list of expenses you have helped cover for fellow parishioners through your generosity to the St. Bernadette Fund:

- rent
- home repairs
- tuition for school (grade school, high school and college)
- school materials
- extraordinary medical bills
- counseling & therapy
- food and groceries
- car repairs
- gas
- legal fees
- funerals & burials
- mission trips
