# Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners.

I hope you had a wonderful Easter and a fruitful Divine Mercy Sunday. So many graces to avail ourselves of! Thank you to all who made these festivities beautiful and successful: choir, sacristans, seminarians, ushers, altar servers, decorating crew, and all the other wonderful volunteers who work behind the scenes.

I would like to give you an overdue update on the various projects we have around the church.

Back Field: After a lengthy search for the right contractor & pavilion design, we applied for permits Fri. 26—Sun. 28 April. Give away a few items you in early February. The county requested changes to the plans; those changes have been made and a new set of plans has been submitted. We continue to wait

> Main Church A/C: Short-term repairs were made to a dying air conditioner last summer, and a new 30-ton HVAC unit was ordered in October! All parts have finally arrived (supply chain issues) and we hope to begin installation this month, weather permitting. This installation involves removing the roof over the sacristy for a day so that the air handler can be craned in. The crane is also necessary for removing the old outdoor unit from the courtyard and putting the new unit in its place.

> Parking Lot/Driveway: We are aware of the deterioration of the parking lot in certain places. We are working with our contractors to rectify the underlying issues. Once these concerns are addressed, we can make repairs and restripe the lot.

> St. Scholastica Chapel: Having ascertained that the leak was successfully repaired and that any major renovations are still only on the horizon, we made the small repairs necessary to give the chapel a more polished and prayerful atmosphere.

> Sanctuary Lamp: While we weren't expecting our old lamp to fail as it did, a new sanctuary lamp fixture was purchased several months ago. The existing counterbalance was insufficient for its weight, so we ordered a new counterbalance and discovered they are made to order and there is a six month lead
