Per Chesterfield County Police: “It has been brought to my attention that there has been an increase in incidents of individuals soliciting for money at houses of worship within the county. Some of these solicitors are Romanian and may bring small children with them for sympathy's sake. One of our officers recognized one of the subjects that scammed a church out of \$2500.00 last year. When the subject was approached by the officer and offered resources the subject refused and was then asked by staff to leave the property.

“I know that part of your mission is to give to those that do not have, and that you want to be welcoming and protective of the less fortunate. Unfortunately, there are those that will take advantage of those with good hearts. If you are solicited or ask for help, I strongly encourage you to offer resources or other assistance prior to giving cash. This will both protect you and may be more appropriate assistance to those in need.”
