Dear Parishioners,

When St. Jean Vianney was assigned to Ars, he took his bag and traveled there on foot. As he was nearing the town, he ran into a small boy and asked him directions to Ars. After the boy pointed the way, St. Jean told him: "You have shown me the way to Ars, I will show you the way to heaven."

Do you show your kids the way to heaven? You have a duty to. When you meet the Lord upon your judgement, He will say: "I have given you this child and that one too... Did you bring them to me? Did you teach them about Me? About My Love? About sanctification?"
