Critical dates for Sacraments

Forms Required by 1 March 25

If your child is in a sacramental prep year, you must provide to the St. Joseph parish office a baptismal certificate from the church of record with seal visible. If the baptism was done at St. Joseph, you must provide the date (at least by month and year) to the Parish Secretary by 1 March 25.

Forms to register the sacrament and fill out the certificate will be provided by the teacher and are also to be submitted by the above date.

Additionally, if your child is being confirmed, you will need to submit a Sponsor Attestation Form which will be provided by the teacher.

There are also 2 essay paragraphs required of each candidate for confirmation which will be due at the time of testing, 18 May.

Sacrament Dates

FHC will be held on Saturday, 17 May 2025. Testing for readiness for First Holy Communion will be held on Sunday 4 May. First Communicants will be interviewed with First Confessions and sacristy tour on 10 May. Every possible accommodation has been considered for those traveling great distances, but these are required events.

Confirmation is tentatively set for 31 May 2025, pending approval by the Bishop. If that date is confirmed, then testing will be held at the usual class time between the Sunday morning Masses on 18 May.
