Pastor’s Corner



Dear Parishioners,

I wanted to give you an update on the many projects underway around the building and our property.

We had several big item repairs/replacements in the past year. Just to name a few: a necessary restructuring of the Fr. Adrian Hall ceiling, a new AC unit for the main church (hopefully the ups and downs have been ironed out), ADA doors for the south entrance, a new automatic gate for the Pinetta entrance, refurbished HVAC corrals, renewal of the Fatima shrine statues, etc.

Looking forward, we still have a long list of big items that need attention. Early next year, we will have necessary maintenance done to preserve and protect the stained-glass windows of the main church. Additionally, the kitchen by the St. Joseph Room is getting a very necessary makeover (new floor and industrial appliances). We will have another gate installed at the main entrance on Buford to limit trespassing at night. The driveway on Buford needs to be repaved. The parking lot needs some patch up work and sealing and the lines repainted. The beautiful new pavilion is being fitted with electricity and lights, and a water line is being run to that area. Picnic tables have been ordered. We will put boulders between the parking lot area and the field/pavilion so that cars can’t drive onto the field. We will be pouring a cement pad to the right of the dumpster corral for a storage shed. We are looking at different options for a nice playground, which will be to the left of the pavilion. We will also be getting a new tractor with a larger mowing deck as a 2-acre field is a large area.

There is A LOT happening, none of which would be possible without your continued support and generosity. My heartfelt thanks and may God reward you!

Please know that you and your families are in my prayers, especially at the Altar of Our Lord.
